- 5. Respect and draw upon the significant features of the diverse ethnic groups within our school and our unique cultural New Zealand heritage.
- 6. Deliver the curriculum through our Curriculum Mapping process that reflects the special nature of our community.
- 7. Develop a programme of continuous self review and reflection.
- 8. Recognise and encourage the development of parents as educators.

- 9. Provide ongoing teacher professional development as the necessary foundation for successful curriculum delivery.
- 10. Reporting to parents, in plain language and in writing, will take place at least twice a year. In addition parents can request an interview at any time.
