

ST FRANCIS XAVIER CATHOLIC SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE

PURPOSE

When implementing this policy the principles of pastoral care, and the Gospel Values of justness, fairness, empathy and consideration towards others will be considered.

To establish a healthy school environment by encouraging children to respect the rights and property of others.

To ensure a consistent approach to discipline throughout the school that respects the individual and reflects the Special character of the school.

To encourage parent/caregiver co-operation and support in the implementation of this policy.

GUIDELINES

- 1. A copy of the school's behaviour code will be available for parents / caregivers and staff.
- 2. Good behaviour will be acknowledged and reinforced.
- 3. Regular discussion and monitoring of the management of children will occur in class and across the school, particularly during duty times.
- 4. The Senior Management staff and the Resource Teacher Learning and Behaviour will be available to all staff members and parents as required, to initiate / support appropriate action in matters of school discipline.
- 5. Parents / Caregivers will be consulted and their support will be enlisted if their child's behaviour at school causes concern. Parents will be encouraged to approach the school, should they have concerns regarding the behaviour of children at St Francis Xavier Catholic School.
- 6. It will be recognised that some children's behaviour modification may require the involvement of support services beyond the school.
- 7. The school recognizes that in addressing children's behaviours there may be a need to support the family system and where applicable resources may be accessed on behalf of the family.

8.	Teachers will report on children's behaviour by entering it on ETap the school pupil management system.
