Advent

What is Advent? Advent is the Church season just before Christmas. It is considered a time of preparation for the coming of Jesus Christ, a time for conversion, anticipation, hope and thanksgiving. Advent begins on the Sunday nearest November 30th, the feast day of St Andrew the apostle. Since the start date changes yearly, so does the length of the Advent season. This year, Advent begins on Sunday 3rd December.

The word Advent means "the coming" in Latin. Advent has been a time of good cheer and spiritual reflection as early as the fourth century. It was originally a time when converts to Christianity readied themselves for baptism. Today, many Christian families have adopted the tradition of lighting the candles on an "Advent Wreath" and using the "Advent Calendar" to count down the days until Christmas.

During this time the school will focus on Advent in their classes, where they will reflect on members of Jesus' family.


