## Dear Parents, Caregivers and Friends of our School,

#### **Principal Message**

Kia ora, Talofa, Malo e lelei, Habari, Hello, Sawadee, Kia orana, Dia duit, Ma muka chini, Kumusta, Namaste, Annyeonghaseyo!

It is great to see our students wearing their school hats and playing safe in the sun. Our seniors have begun their swimming programme. It is very important that students have plenty of water during the day. A good tip is to add some ice cubes or keep water bottles in the fridge overnight.

Our amazing <u>PTFA is meeting at 7pm tonight in the staffroom.</u> Everyone is welcome and supper is provided. Please forward this on to any school parents or caregivers who may be interested in coming, and bring them along with you. Our PTFA do amazing things for our school and help with fundraising for resources that are much needed for our school and students. They would love to see new faces!

Our teaching staff attended literacy professional development on Monday. This was a great opportunity to learn about current pedagogy and look into best fit literacy additions for our students. Our support staff all attended their refresher First Aid course, which is fantastic.

Students have begun their Lenten focus and are learning about renewing their promises. Lent is about prayer, fasting and almsgiving (giving to others in some way). Lent is a 40 day season that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by almsgiving and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptised into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

Last week Maria Wilson, our DRS and myself attended the Dedication Mass for the Auckland Diocese at Christ the King Parish Auckland. It was a wonderful opportunity to catch up with our fellow Catholic schools and their staff and the great team in the Diocese. Bishop Steve delivered a great homily that spoke about our choices during Lent, and to be more at peace and appreciative of what and who we have in our lives.

Parking and pick ups. The church car park gets very busy. So we strongly encourage our parents and caregivers to utilise the Marist carpark. We are fortunate to have this accessible for our use. Students are brought across after school by a teacher, to the car park and supervised until picked up, please be at the Marist carpark no later than 3.15pm. This reduces congestion at the church car park, saves parents and caregivers time as the students are brought to them and they don't have to wait for a park, and helps students to stay safe.

#### Lent

Lent (which begins on Ash Wednesday) is a time for renewal and Easter preparation. The children will discuss the season of Lent and Lenten promises. A good way to remind your child(ren) about these Lenten discussions is to ask them questions.

#### Faith Fact: The Season of Lent

The season of Lent is one of the two Penitential seasons of the year. It starts with Ash Wednesday and lasts forty days finishing in Holy Week. It is a time for fasting, prayer and almsgiving. Lent allows people to reflect on their lives and identify what they need to change. It is a season of preparation for the feast of Jesus' Resurrection which is the greatest feast in the Church's calendar.

#### **Family Masses**

During the year, Whanau will be rostered to participate in Family Masses on Sunday at 10:00 am. These Whanau Masses have been a success in recent years and it is a beautiful way of coming together as a school and Parish whanau to celebrate the Eucharist. 
